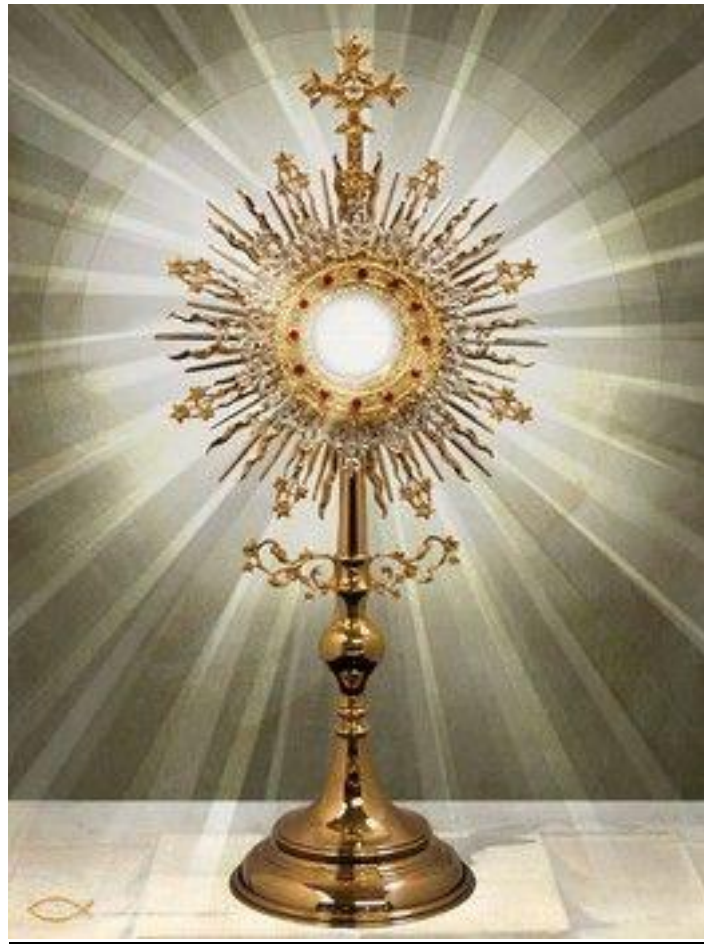

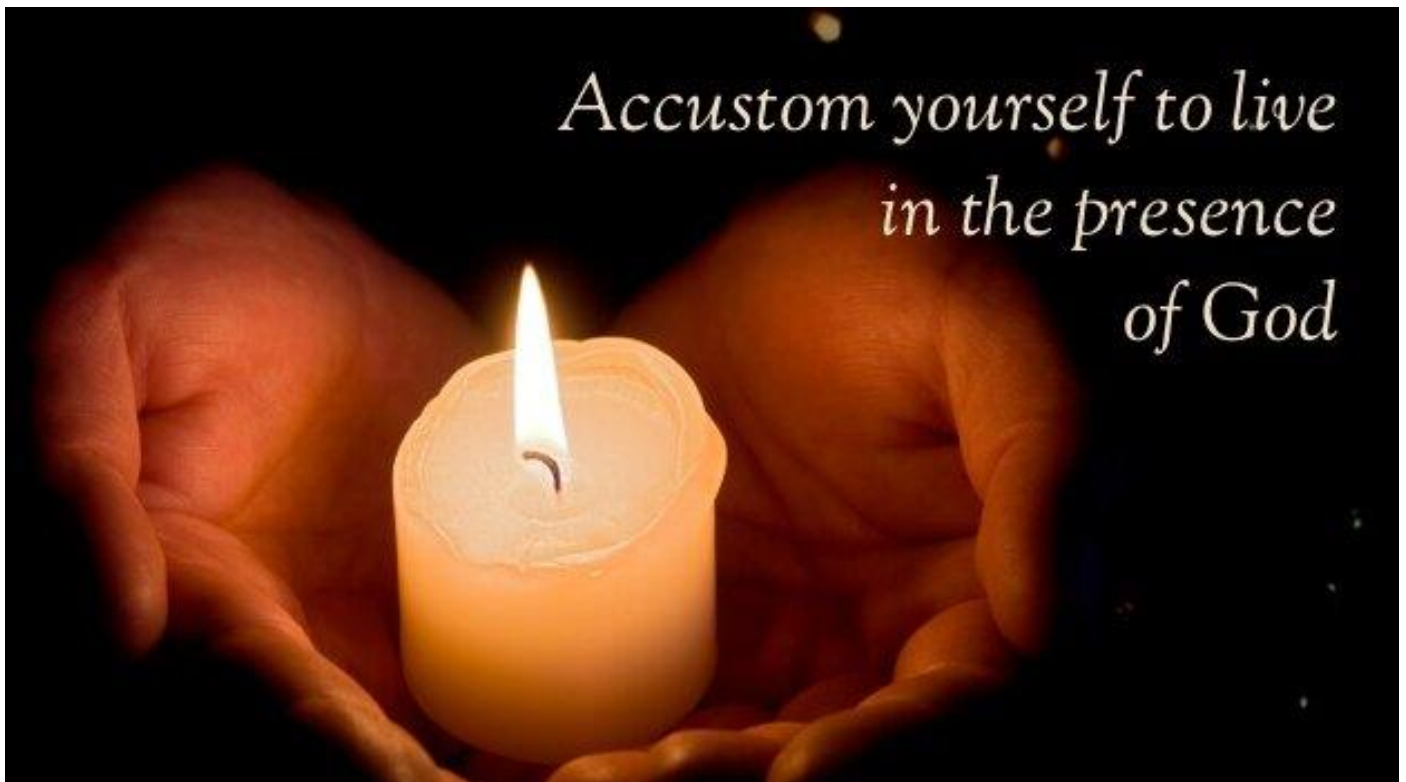
The official message of Pope Francis for Lent 2021:
