



Churches Together in Winchester

Churches Together in Winchester (CTW) brings together 25 constituent churches in Winchester and District. It provides a means for local Christian Churches to co-ordinate their activities, and to worship together at significant times in the Christian calendar - typically Christian Unity Week, Good Friday and Pentecost.

CTW member churches support many of the local charities serving the Winchester community, such as The Boaz Project, Emmaus, Naomi House, Olive Branch Counselling, Winchester Basics Bank, Winchester Churches Nightshelter, Trinity Centre, MHA Communities (Live at Home), and Winchester Street Pastors. A number of these community charities were actually initiated by CTW.

CTW has appointed champions speaking out on the particular issues of : AntiTrafficking & Slavery, Prayer, Homelessness and Debt, Chaplaincy, Disadvantaged and Vulnerable Families, Climate Justice, Business, Refugees and Older People. The champions provide a focal point for co-ordinating the Christian voice on such issues.
