
# First Part: The Solemn Beginning of the Vigil or Lucernarium (Service of Light)





After the Old Testament readings, each with its Responsorial Psalm and its prayer, the altar candles are lit, the priest intones the Gloria and the bells are rung











The Litany of the Saints calls on saints of all ages, patrons of our parish and of those entering the Church, as we pray for the life of the Church and those being received into it.



  Ever with the Spirit be.







Deacon: Go in the peace of Christ! Alleluia! Alleluia!


All: Thanks be to God! Alleluia! Alleluia!
