You can give in person through our offertory collection during any weekend mass. If you are able to gift aid, please consider using one of our gift aid envelopes

GIFT AID

Gift Aid is a scheme that lets UK taxpayers easily increase their charitable donations at no extra cost to you as an individual. Every time you say 'yes' to Gift Aid, each £10 you give becomes £12.50 for the church at no extra cost to you. If you would like to gift aid, just tick the box on the page opposite and a form will be sent to you. *If you are Higher Rate Taxpayer, you can claim the additional amount direct from HMRC through your own Personal Tax Code*

Reviewing Your Giving

For Catholics giving to the Church is an act of worship in response to the generosity of God, and a contribution to the mission of spreading his Kingdom. When we give to the Church, we are paying God back from what is already his. 'Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand.' (1 Chron 29:14) What you give to the parish is up to you. Some people follow the Biblical principle of tithing (giving 10% of their income), but understandably not everyone can. As St Paul reminds us 'Each person should give what they have decided in their heart to give, not reluctantly nor under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.' (2 Cor 9:7)
